Submission Guidelines for 2024

For its prestigious Citizenship Award the Shelter Island Lions Club selects annually (an) individual(s) who has/have demonstrated outstanding voluntary service to the Shelter Island community. The Shelter Island Lions Club recognizes that outstanding citizenship describes a member of society whose service to the community far exceeds the duties and obligations that are the normal functions of being a citizen.

The Shelter Island Lions Club Citizenship Award Committee seeks nominations for the award from all members of the Shelter Island community. Nominated individuals need not be members of the Shelter Island Lions Club. The Shelter Island Lions Club Board votes on the nominations and selects (an) awardee(s) at its meeting in March. The award is usually presented at a dinner in May to which all Islanders are invited and a description of the service performed by the awardee(s) is published in the Shelter Island Reporter and Shelter Island Gazette.

The following are general guidelines to be considered when nominating individuals for the Citizenship Award:

- 1. The person or persons should have demonstrated a profound commitment to serve in a voluntary capacity the needs of the people of Shelter Island.
- 2. This award recognizes people who, through exceptional efforts, have made outstanding contributions to the well-being of the Shelter Island community and whose assistance was given without expectation of recognition or reward.
- 3. The service provided may have been in either a leadership or a following role.
- 4. Nominee(s) may have been nominated in previous years, but must not have received the award. A list of previous awardees is provided on the following page.
- 5. A nomination form is provided and additional pages may be used as needed.
- 6. Nominations may be mailed, e-mailed, faxed or given to one of the Committee members, no later than Thursday, February 15, 2024. The names of members of the Shelter Island Lions Club 2024 Citizenship Award Committee are provided below.
